Respect for neighbours: The accommodation is located in a shared building. Please respect the peace and quiet of your neighbours.

Care of furniture: Please take care of the accommodation (bar stools, sofa bed, bed...). If an accident occurs, please notify us by message (via the app or SMS) before your departure.

End of Stay & Departure

Rubbish: Please empty and take out your rubbish before departure. You will find bins provided for this purpose on the main avenue.

Household linen: Please place all dirty linen (towels, sheets, tea towels) in the laundry basket located behind the bedroom door.

Additional Charges (in case of non-compliance)

Smoking in the accommodation: €100 flat-rate cleaning fee.

Damage to furniture: Charged at the replacement value of the damaged item.

Damage to the apartment: Charged according to the extent of repairs needed. (Note: a thorough inspection is carried out the day before each arrival).

Paid Parking



Rue de l'Hotel de la Croix Blanche is located in the heart of Millau's historic pedestrian area, **it is not possible to park there directly**. However, several very large car parks surround this area within a 5-minute walk.

Parking Emma Calvé

 6 Rue du Preche or Place Emma Calvé | Distance: ~1 to 2 min walk (150m)

Underground car park, safe and covered. The closest to the accommodation.

 Good to know: the first 30 minutes are free. Daily or weekend passes can be booked in advance on their website.

Parking Capelle

 Boulevard des Gantieres | Distance: ~4 min walk (300m)

Underground car park beneath the Capelle shopping centre (315 spaces). Open 24/7.

 Good to know: the first hour is sometimes free via tickets distributed by city centre shops. Also accessible via online booking.

Free Parking



For travellers who wish to leave their car free of charge throughout their stay, the town of Millau has large free car parks located within a 10-minute walk of the accommodation.

P Parking de la Grave (Most recommended)

📍 Chemin de la Grave | Distance: ~6 min walk

Nearly 300 free spaces. Very large, easy to access, recently expanded by the town. The ideal place to leave your car for several days in a row.

P Parking Victor Hugo

📍 Boulevard Victor Hugo | Distance: ~7 min walk

Large surface car park. Excellent alternative if Parking de la Grave is full, very close to the historic centre.

P Parking des Hortes

📍 Rue des Hortes | Distance: ~7 min walk

175 free spaces. Very well located east of the town centre, perfect for reaching the accommodation quickly on foot.

P Parking des Coopérateurs

📍 Bd de la Solidarité / Rue des Coopérateurs | Distance: ~7 to 8 min walk

100 free spaces. Good backup option if the other car parks are full.
